World Day of Prayer for the Sick - 11th February 2021

World Day of the Sick, an observation started by Pope St. John Paul II as a way for believers to offer prayers for those suffering from illnesses. The day coincides with the commemoration of Our Lady of Lourdes. People around the world on this day take the time to pray for the sick and for those who work very hard to alleviate the sufferings of the sick. Pope St. John Paul II initiated the day in 1992 to encourage people to pray for those who suffer from illness and for their caregivers. The Pope himself had been diagnosed with Parkinson's a year before, in 1991, and it is considered that his own illness was the impetus for his designation of the day. Pope Emeritus, Benedict XVI, also declared his decision to resign from his post as the Pope on this day in 2013. He cited his failing health as the reason behind his decision.
