EXTRAORDINARY MINISTERS

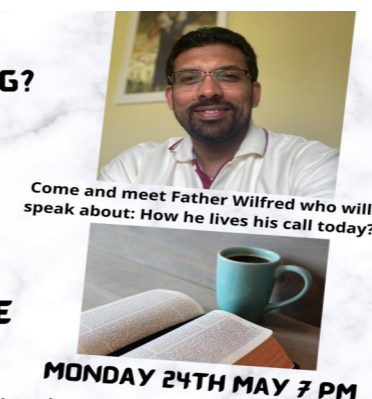
